
## Supply List



These should be regular pencils with erasers, mechanical pencils are ok, but make sure you have a supply of lead to refill your pencils if you are going to use them. The teachers do not have lead for refilling mechanical pencils in class. Make sure to bring PENCILS to class, as using pens for coursework is not accepted by teachers.



You will need a notepad that you can take pages out of to write notes, complete homework, take quizzes, etc.. There are several teachers who will not accept paper with "fringe" on the edges. Each student will need a composition notebook (no spiral) for science & another for English.



Every teacher <u>requires</u> that you have a folder for their class. Different colors may help in keeping you more organized.



TWO packs of colored pencils, one will stay in Mrs. Tom's room. The other will be for homework and other classes. Mrs. Carter requires students to have colored pencils for science as well. No markers or crayons please.



Every student should to bring in two boxes of Kleenex to your FIRST period teacher.



Calculator for science and math. A simple scientific calculator will be fine. Phones & iPads will not be allowed for this function.



According to current middle school students you may want to get some "extras" like erasers, a highlighter to make studying notes easier, pencil case or pouch for all your writing utensils, and a small pencil sharpener. They also suggest you have these supplies available at home and a good study space so you don't get distracted.
