Suicide Prevention Month: Good morning. This week we are going to be discussing suicide prevention. This is a difficult and personal topic. At any time this week or throughout the year if you or someone you know has thoughts of harming themselves, please speak to a counselor, trusted adult, or friend.

We are going to be learning 5 steps to Be The One To help.

The first step is to ask. Ask the tough questions. When somebody you know is in emotional pain, ask them directly: "Are you thinking about suicide?" It is okay to ask and it is okay to be honest and share your thoughts and feelings with someone you trust.

If you are struggling, reach out to a friend, a school counselor, a teacher, a trusted adult, or text or call the Suicide and Crisis Lifeline at 988.
